L'Oréal New Zealand and the New Zealand Hair & Beauty Industry Training Organisation (HITO) are offering ten scholarships for care experienced people within the beauty industry.

The scholarships will allow you to complete an apprenticeship through HITO, working in barbering, beauty, or hairdressing businesses, earning a wage and gaining workplace skills while you train.

Apprenticeships are the best way to get qualified. You will receive hands-on skills in a real work environment, earning while you are learning, so you end up with a qualification, minus the student loan.

Selection Criteria

Applications will be selected and meet the following criteria;

- Demonstrate a genuine interest in the hairdressing, beauty therapy or barbering industry
- Show a desire to succeed in a hairdressing, beauty therapy or barbering apprenticeship
- Are committed to completing the full qualification
- Are seeking employment in the chosen industry
- Enjoy working with people

Selection Process

The selection panel will review all applications and the applicant may be required to attend an interview if the scholarship applicant is shortlisted.

The panel includes L'Oréal New Zealand Human Resources and Corporate Communications team, and the General Management Team at HITO New Zealand.

It is favourable for applicants to have completed the L'Oréal Face Your Future programme; however, it is not a compulsory requirement.

Selection Conditions

- The successful scholarship applications will be awarded on the basis that the information supplied is true and correct.
- Minimum of 16 years of age at the start of your apprenticeship employment.
- A New Zealand citizen or New Zealand permanent resident.
- You may currently be living in care, or living independently.
- The decision of the selection panel is final.
