We develop and support apprenticeship and on-job training qualifications for career and business success. As the government-appointed standard setting body, we work with our industries and NZQA to develop qualifications. Our vision is for 100% of people in our industries to be 100% New Zealand qualified.

These are contract roles that fit in with people currently working in the industry. Successful new applicants will participate in an induction programme.

As a contract Industry Assessor, you will be expected to:

- complete pre-assessment "Guidelines" meetings with apprentices who are ready to sit their final assessments
- assess practical final assessments:
 - 2757 Apply hairdressing services under workplace conditions
 - 2759 Perform hairdressing services in a commercial salon
 - 10650 Perform barbering services and run a barber chair in a commercial salon
- mark theory assessments, including Gateway marking
- provide feedback to the apprentice on the assessment
- report results and completed documents to HITO.

The criteria an Industry Assessor must meet are:

- hold a NZ Trade Certificate in Hairdressing or National/NZ Certificate or accepted equivalent
- be actively involved in a commercial salon for a minimum of 25 hours per week
- have a minimum of three years' experience following your qualification
- have unit standards 4098 and 11552
- follow the Guidelines for Assessment of 2757 and 2759, or 10650
- show currency through professional development within the industry
- fully participate in an induction programme for new, independent assessors
- attend annual assessor training and be involved in moderation.

Industry Assessors are required to:

- be well organised and presented
- maintain a professional and inclusive environment
- be able to assess multiple candidates at the same time
- use effective communication with salon and barbershop owners, apprentices, HITO staff and other industry assessors.
- ensure effective written record-keeping and reporting.
